### It's Orleans County Day Kent/Albion, NY

Who knew we had these gems in the county right next door to us! Our day starts out by filling our bellies at a yummy mid-1800's restaurant known as the **Black North Inn**. The buffet will include: burgundy beef tips, chicken cutlets with apple dijon mustard sauce, vegetables, herb roasted potatoes, salad, dinner rolls and a homemade dessert. It's then over to the opposite end of Orleans County to visit **The Cabaret at Studio B** for some comedy from the **Reverend Mother**, whose ability to think fast on her feet brings laughter to every audience. At age 75, she is still hysterical and compelling. The fun and excitement continue after the show as we cover a small portion of the Cobblestone Trail by visiting the **Cobblestone Museum** on Route 104 at Route 98. This museum is a National Historic Landmark as well. Fun fact did you know that Orleans County has over 100 cobblestone sites? Be sure to join us on this fun-filled day.

### Oh Canada Day

Niagara Falls, Ontario Canada

We are crossing the border and it's off to explore beautiful Niagara Falls, Canada. Why not start out at an exotic place such as the World's Largest Free-Flying Indoor Aviary - **Bird Kingdom**. Discover hundreds of tropical birds as you explore the pathways throughout the multi-level rainforest. Plan to meet friendly parrots and exotic animals at Bird Kingdom's Animal Encounters. Explore the ruins of the Night Jungle that is home to many fascinating nocturnal creatures. Lorikeet Landing provides an unforgettable experience where you may feed and interact with the playful lorikeet birds. If you haven't had enough of the rainforest yet, plan for some delicious food at **The Rainforest Café** as the decor inside will captivate you. The last portion of the day will lead us to the **Butterfly Conservatory**. Step inside one of the largest glass-enclosed butterfly conservatories in North America and discover a tropical garden oasis. The Niagara Parks Butterfly Conservatory features over 2,000 vibrantly colored butterflies fluttering freely throughout winding pathways adorned with lush vegetation and trickling waterfalls. **Don't forget your proof of citizenship!** A rest stop to Tim Horton's will be offered on the way home (\$). Lunch Choices include the choice of one of the following and a dessert scoop of vanilla ice cream with chocolate syrup:

- Philly Cheese Sandwich - Shaved steak smothered with fajita vegetables, mozzarella cheese served on a hoagie bun with a side of Safari Jungle Fries.
- Grilled Chicken Sandwich - Tender grilled chicken breast topped with melted Swiss cheese, served on a sesame seed bun with tomato, lettuce and a side of Safari Jungle Fries.
- Anaconda Pasta - Cavatappi pasta, local garden vegetables, basil, shaved parmesan cheese, red pepper flakes, and white wine tomato sauce.

## **Finger Lakes Fun**

Canandaigua – Naples, NY

Our Finger Lakes fun day begins at **Finger Lakes Gaming & Racetrack** and it's Senior Day! New players that have NEVER had a card and get one will get \$10 free play. NO FREE PLAY IS AUTOMATIC ON THIS TRIP, but have 90 minutes to play, discover and eat or drink while there. By now, you have worked up an appetite and are ready for our trip to **Arbor Hill for Brews & Brats**. Established in 2011, Brews & Brats was a venture built upon the rich historical significance and enjoyment of hops, an integral ingredient of beer. The Bristol Springs Brand craft beers served exclusively at Brew & Brats at Arbor Hill were developed by a team of ten dedicated beer lovers who worked tirelessly at the end of the 2011 season to agree on the delightful balance of flavors found in their pale ale, IPA and porter. Arbor Hill then partnered with Artisan Meats from Canandaigua to offer nothing but the best in taste and quality when it comes to their brats. The featured sausage is made with Arbor Hill Sherried Wine BBQ Sauce which has been a staple at Arbor Hill almost since the winery opened in 1987 – hence Brews & Brats. The meal consists of a brat and a side along with a soda, beer, or wine. The meal will also include your choice of German Potato Salad, Billy's Baked Beans, Winemaker's Sauerkraut, Route 11 bag of Chips, or a side salad. The main entree choice is the following:

- Bristol Brat – savory herbal Austrian style brat with pork, onion, garlic, oregano, and parsley
- Chicken Supremo – a mix of customary Italian seasonings
- Frankfurter – a mix of pork and beef, lightly smoked and mildly seasoned
- Arbor Hill Sherried Wine Sausage – ground pork marinated with Arbor Hill Sherried Wine BBQ sauce

Our tour continues over to Canandaigua Lake for a ride on **The Canandaigua Lady**. Relax in the summer sun while listening to a captivating narration about the 19th century Mississippi styler paddle wheel boat on this beautiful lake. Our Finger Lakes day wouldn't be complete without a stop to **Scoops Ice Cream**.

## **A Day in the Country**

Portville – Ellicottville, NY

Sit back and relax as we make our way to the Enchanted Mountains to visit **Griffis Sculpture Park** with a guide to talk about the history which features over 250 large scale sculptures. Since the early 60's, the steel sculptures of Larry Griffis, Jr. and other international artists have been residing in the woods, fields, and even ponds of Griffis Sculpture Park, which is one of the oldest and largest sculpture parks in the U.S. It's then onto **Sprague's Maple Farms** for a scrumptious down home country meal which can be breakfast or lunch:

- Hot Turkey Sandwich w/homemade gravy, cranberry sauce and choice of mashed potatoes or fries
- Turkey N' Biscuits w/ homemade gravy over fresh country biscuit, mashed potatoes served w/cranberry sauce
- Mainline - 2 buttermilk pancakes, 2 eggs w/choice of bacon, maple sausage or country ham
- Texas French Toast w/choice of bacon, maple sausage or country ham

After lunch, the trip continues to the Southern Tier of Western New York in the foothills of the Allegheny Mountains for a visit to Main Street of **Ellicottville** with free time to shop on your own and enjoy the quaint village. A comfort stop to Tim Hortons will be offered on the way home (\$).

Who's ready for a fun-filled day as we start it out right with lunch at the **Inn Between Restaurant** in Camillus. Once a manor home and a thriving Guernsey dairy farm. Entrée choices include one of the following and dessert:

- Stuffed Chicken Breast with apple cranberry chicken supreme sauce
- Tender Roast Beef with bordelaise sauce
- Boston Baked Scrod with lemon and crumb topping

It's then over to the Rev Theater Co. for **A Chorus Line**. This production examines one day in the lives of seventeen dancers, all vying for a spot in the "chorus line" of a new Broadway musical. Set in the 1970's and based on real Broadway dancers' stories, as told to fellow dancer and director/choreographer Michael Bennett, A Chorus Line strips away the anonymity of the chorus to reveal fascinating and dimensional artists. Celebrating the lives, careers, and legacies of the "First Couple of Comedy," and their incredible impact on the world. The Lucy Desi Museum features exact re-creations of studio sets from the beloved TV sitcom I Love Lucy, including Lucy and Ricky Ricardo's New York City apartment and Hollywood hotel suite. Also on display are screen-used costumes and props, Emmy Awards, and scripts from this legendary TV series. We then go back in time for a lunch buffet and experience a re-creation of Ricky Ricardo's famous Manhattan night club, the **Tropicana Room**. Enjoy a deliciously themed meal while watching your favorite episode of I Love Lucy. The comedy continues and the **National Comedy Center** awaits us. Inspired by Lucille Ball's vision for her hometown to become a destination for the celebration of comedy, the National Comedy Center features over 50 immersive exhibits that take you on a laugh-filled, interactive journey through the world of comedy, as you explore stand-up performances, movies, TV and radio shows, cartoons, comic strips and the internet to discover the great works and iconic performers who have elevated comedy to an art form. This trip includes \$20 free play, \$10 food credit and a ticket to the matinee show - **Merry Christmas Darling music from The Carpenters** at 2 p.m. This casino concert is celebrating one of the most successful recording acts of all time with their classic Christmas repertoire and a full complement of their biggest hits. #### Cancellations & Refund Policy:

1. Cancellations received in the Recreation Department (392-9030) prior to the trip registration deadline may be refunded with a processing fee of 10%. Cancellations received after the deadline or "no shows" will **NOT** receive a refund unless someone else is found to take the place of the cancelled party. **We will attempt to give refunds when possible, but please realize that refunds are NOT guaranteed.** If a refund is approved, you have the option to put a credit for the amount paid on your account to be used later.
2. All replacements will be handled by the Recreation Department from the waiting list if one exists.

#### Registration Procedure and Information:

1. Pick-up and departure from Hilton Senior Center, 59 Henry Street, Hilton, NY.
2. **Since the Town of Parma and the Hilton Senior Center subsidizes these trips, they are open to Town of Parma** residents age 55 and up at a subsidized rate. Those who do not live in the Town of Parma will be accommodated if space is available; however, they will be required to register at a non-resident rate according to the trip dates for each trip.
3. The following is the procedure for trip registration: Complete registration form or register online at [www.hprecreation.org](http://www.hprecreation.org) at any time after a trip is advertised. Completed forms should be turned into the Recreation Office. For any seating requests, submit information on the registration form with any other requirements such as food choice and emergency contact. We cannot hold spots for people without payment any longer. We will take a waiting list if a bus fills. If cancellations occur, placements will be taken in order from the waiting list.
4. We recommend that interested participants register for any trip as soon as you can to guarantee a spot. Keep in mind that there are trip deadlines to meet minimum numbers – this is extremely important.
5. **REMINDER:** The first two sets of seats are reserved for those who have a difficult time maneuvering up and down the aisle and will be rotated to share this opportunity to all.  
**NOTE:** Front seat requests will be taken at registration, but please be aware that these seats are limited.
6. Please be at the pick-up point at least 10 minutes prior to the designated departure time. **Passengers cannot board the bus without the travel escort and seats cannot be saved.**
7. We are required to have a minimum number of people attend each trip. If our minimum is not reached, other options will be explored, including a possible cancellation of the trip.
8. Payment by check, cash, money order, MasterCard, Discover or Visa is accepted. Make checks payable to: **Town of Parma.**
9. Other day trips not included on this document may be added throughout the year.
