Lewiston-Niagara, NY

Get ready to go back in history as we pick up our costumed guide of the times in Lockport, to start the journey that many African Americans made enroute to freedom. We will travel to some local towns and sites in Western New York that played host to the thousands of runaways who passed through. Plan to visit some of the **Underground Railroad sites from Lockport to Niagara Falls** and **Freedom Crossing Monument Statue**, where you will have the opportunity to get off the bus to get the best view. In hopes of building up your appetite, our lunch location will be the **Apple Granny Restaurant** in Lewiston – see food options below. We then bid adieu to our morning guide, as he leaves us and we continue to Niagara Falls to the **Niagara Falls Underground Railroad Heritage Center** and experience more of what our guide enlightened us with. Now that you're educated to the fullest on the Underground Railroad, we now fill your belly with dessert as we make a stop at **Becker Farms.** How about a piece of pie with your choice of iced tea or lemonade before we get back to Hilton? You've got it! Lunch options are:

Medina-South Dayton, NY

The day begins at **Bent's Opera House** in Medina, as they host us for coffee and muffins along with a tour of the three-story renovated 1865 Opera House - "Where the Past meets the Present". There's no time to waste as we head south to catch the train in Gowanda, home to the **New York & Lake Erie Railroad Station** for a 40-minute ride to our lunch destination. **The South Dayton Hotel** awaits to serve us and is located at the corner of Pine & Railroad streets in South Dayton, NY putting us in the heart of Amish Country! If time permits, there is a small museum in the old railroad station to view shots from the movies "Planes, Trains and Automobiles" and "The Natural" that were filmed right in South Dayton. It's not big, but it is an authentic classic old train station with a very small gift shop – a unique and hidden gem! It's then time to re-board the train for our ride back to Gowanda. Our final stop for the day will be to **the Marilla Country Store** where they celebrate 170 years of never having closed their doors. They offer unique gifts, rustic home décor, food and candy and one of a kind handmade items.

Cancellations & Refund Policy:

- Cancellations received in the Recreation Department (392-9030) prior to the trip registration deadline may be refunded with a processing fee of 10%. Cancellations received after the deadline or "no shows" will <u>NOT</u> receive a refund unless someone else is found to take the place of the cancelled party. We will attempt to give refunds when possible, but please realize that refunds are NOT guaranteed. If a refund is approved, you have the option to put a credit for the amount paid on your account to be used later.
- 2. All replacements will be handled by the Recreation Department from the waiting list if one exists.

Registration Procedure and Information:

- 1. Pick-up and departure from Hilton Senior Center, 59 Henry Street, Hilton, NY.
- 2. <u>Since the Town of Parma and the Hilton Senior Center subsidizes these trips, they are open to Town of Parma</u> residents age 55 and up at a subsidized rate. Those who do not live in the Town of Parma will be accommodated if space is available; however, they will be required to register at a non-resident rate according to the trip dates for each trip.
- 3. The following is the procedure for trip registration: Register in person or register online at <u>www.hprecreation.org</u> based upon registration opening dates or any time after that opening date if there are available spots. For any seating requests, submit information on the registration form with any other requirements such as food choice and emergency contact. We cannot hold spots for people without payment. Payment should be made online or in person with recreation staff as these trips are in high demand. We will take a waiting list if a bus fills. If cancellations occur, placements will be taken in order from the waiting list.
- 4. We recommend that interested participants register for any trip as soon as possible to guarantee a spot. Keep in mind that there are trip deadlines to meet minimum numbers this is extremely important. All of these trips will fill very quickly.
- 5. **<u>REMINDER</u>**: The first two <u>sets</u> of seats are reserved for those who have a difficult time maneuvering up and down the aisle and will be rotated to share this opportunity to all. Please state if you need a front seat or even if you need to be towards the front of the bus.

NOTE: Front seat requests will be taken at registration, but please be aware that these seats are limited.

- 6. Please be at the pick-up point <u>at least 10 minutes</u> before the designated departure time. <u>Passengers cannot board</u> <u>the bus without the travel escort and seats cannot be saved.</u>
- 7. We are required to have a minimum number of people attend each trip. If our minimum is not reached, other options will be explored, including a possible cancellation of the trip.
- 8. Payment by check, cash, money order, MasterCard, Discover or Visa is accepted. Make checks payable to: <u>Town</u> <u>of Parma</u>.
- 9. Other day trips not included on this document may be added throughout the year.
- 10. Friendly reminders: bring a drink, snack, cell phone and something to read as well as a sweater or jacket as sometimes the bus can be cool. Additionally, please park around the perimeter of the parking lot and not occupy any handicap spots as these trips are lengthy and prime parking spots should be kept for those that are needing to do business at the community center.
